B1 (AI 1.15) - Radiolocation Service Allocations for Oceanographic Radar Applications in the 3 to 50 MHz Range:

Concerning 5250-5450kHz, the Club opposes this revision as it omits any reference to an Amateur Service allocation in this band. This is a matter which was the subject of a previous consultation in May, 2012 (Gazette Notice SMSE-010-12) on which Industry Canada has taken no action. The Club urges the inclusion of the Amateur Service as a secondary service in this band.

B3 (AI 1.23) - Secondary Amateur Allocation in the 415 to 526.5 kHz Range:

The Club supports the revision as presented in the consultation paper.
