

- Owner has very positive impression of Amateur Radio









- Three logging computers networked using N3FJP software
- Laptops at eye level, separate keyboards
- WSJT for 6 Meters and 2 Meters
- Bricks have individual cooling fans

- 3 Towers (24, 30 and 30 feet), with rotators
